

# Post-vaccination



### What should I do if I have side effects after taking the first and/or second dose?

After each dose, the doctor should inform you about the possibility of side effects and how to manage them. You will also be advised to continue to follow the protective measures. You can report any adverse events at the vaccination site. On the <u>Vaccinovigilence platform «yaqadaliqah»</u> you can report any effects you experience yourself. A doctor listed on the platform will advise you and guide you to the nearest hospital.

#### What is Yakadaliqah and how to use it?

As part of the COVID-19 vaccination campaign, a computer application called «Yakadaliqah» is made available to the population to enable the reporting of adverse vaccine reactions. A doctor will review the reports and guide the vaccinated people on the appropriate management. The Yakadaliqah platform will be activated only after you have visited the vaccination centre and agreed to the remote monitoring. Please also check your internet connection and your login and password.

## Should I continue to apply barrier measures to prevent the spread of the virus?

Barrier measures (wearing masks, handwashing and physical distancing) will be maintained until 80% of the population has achieved herd immunity. Any changes will be communicated by the Ministry of Health.

#### Where can I get proof of vaccination?
